1,250 Wyvern Bred Merino Ewes

May/June 2016 drop Jul shorn, mulesed, treated with Eureka Gold off shears, all needles and animal health treatments are up to date. Wool cut 4.3 kgs greasy at 6 ½ mths growth. NSM

2,100 Wyvern Bred Merino Ewes

May/June 2012 drop Aug shorn, mulesed, treated with Eureka Gold off shears, all needles and animal health treatments are up to date. Marked 116.5 % lambs. Wool cut 7.2 kgs at 12 mths growth. NSM

7,000 Wyvern Bred Wether Lambs

May/June 2017 drop unshorn, jetted with Extinosad at weaning.

The Wyvern flock is Hazeldean based, with contract bred rams coming from Hazeldean and Cooma. The flock is classed by Craig Wilson. The breeding flock average 18.7 micron, whilst the lambs are 2 micron finer.

Wethers are regularly entered in the Peter Westblade wether trial in which our sheep consistently perform very well. Most recently, our Autumn 2015 drop wethers had above average greasy and clean wool weights, at 6.9kg and 4.3kg respectively. These results contributed to an outstanding Schlumberger Yield of 64.1%, the highest result from an Autumn drop team. Our wethers also produced the highest wool value of their class, at \$55.52. This price was the third highest of the 50 teams entered in the 2016-18 - Challenge. Other pleasing results -

included an average micron on 18.4 and a net \$/ha of \$374.66.

Rams going into the flock are selected through the use of the MP + Index. The main production traits selected for seek to increase both fleece and body weight, whilst reducing micron. The sheep are very well known for their easy care and ability to generate excellent financial returns, and will suit any breeding objective.

The sale will run in conjunction with Auctions Plus and full assessments of the sheep will be available from the Auctions Plus website from the 19th of September. All sheep will be presented in wonderful condition and are the annual drafts of surplus sheep from Wyvern Station. Trucks will be available on the sale day.

All lines to be sold in 4 and 6 deck lots and all sheep are required to be taken for delivery on the day.
